- HALLOWED** — Your life reflects the holiness of God
- KINGDOM & WILL** — Your life pursues the mission and goals that reflects God's kingdom

6 Aspects to Living Life as Prayer

- BREAD** — Live like God is the source for every provision in our life.
- FORGIVENESS** — Treat people the way you want God to treat you.
- TEMPTATION** — Live every aspect of your life (thought, word, & deed) as if Jesus was right beside you.

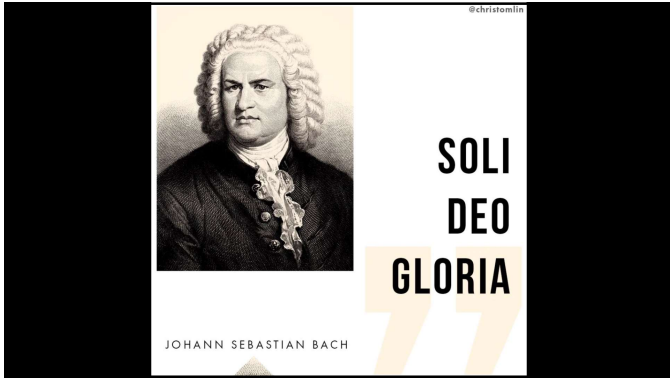

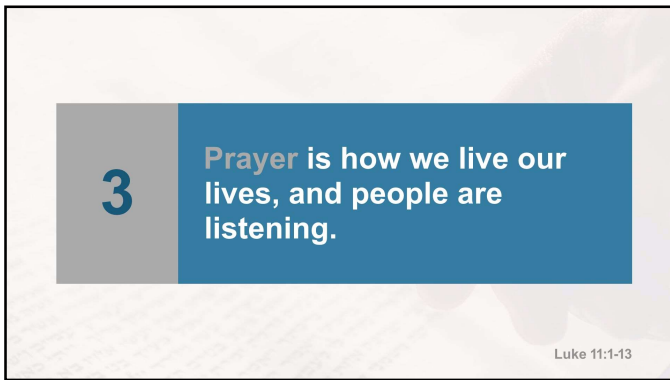

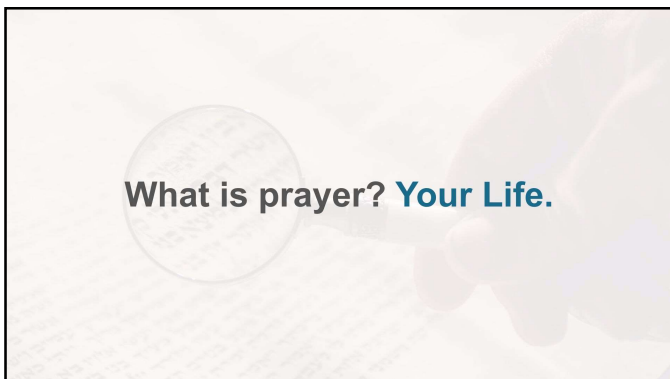
